EAGLE is an integrated database system that provides innovative, real-time solutions for automating logistics tasks. Acquired enables the production and management of modular units of information in accordance with AECMA 1000, Def Stan 00-60 and ATA iSPEC 2200 Electronic Documentation requirements. Aspect enables the creation, delivery, receipt and review of Initial Provisioning data in accordance with AECMA 2000, Def Stan 00-60 ISSP EDI requirements and ATA 2000.

On April 28, we will be conducting a night time meeting to be held at Dad Miller's Golf Course in Anaheim, CA. Mr Edward Welch will be our guest speaker. He will provide discussion on SOLE now and the future. He'll share with us plans that will be beneficial to our chosen career in Logistics. Question: *“What factors does logistics delay time contain’?”*

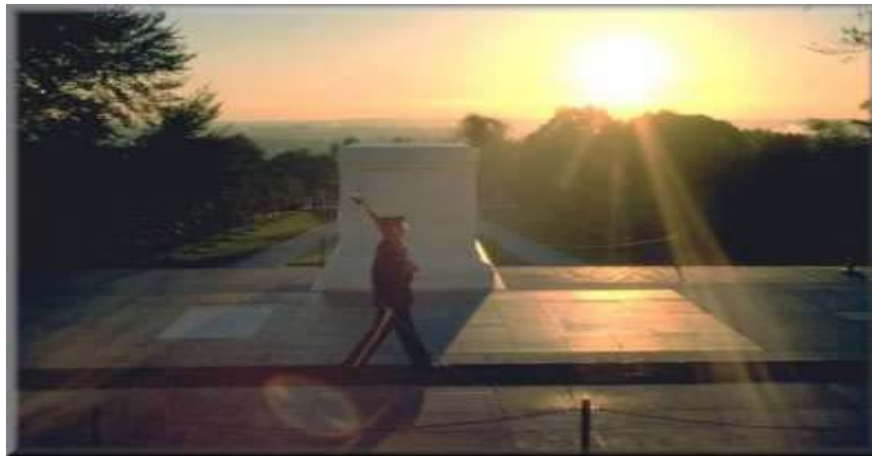
Answer: Logistics delay time contains waiting transportation, waiting for a maintenance facility, and lack of test equipment but does not contain organizational constraints.
